Public consulted on Raven Underground Coal Project

Close to 300 people had the opportunity to ask questions and take a close-up look at the preliminary planning currently underway for the proposed Raven Underground Coal Project at an Open House held last night at the Fanny Bay Community Hall.

“It is important for us to hear directly from the community in these early stages of project planning,” said John Tapics, Compliance Coal CEO and President. “We are very pleased to see the degree of interest the community has expressed in the project.”

Information panels set up around the community hall described the technical and environmental studies currently underway for the proposed project, the public engagement process and the provincial government’s environmental assessment certification requirements. Members of the public asked questions and provided comment directly to the project team and environmental consultants.

The Fanny Bay Open House follows a number of small group meetings held recently with representatives from residents’ associations, environmental groups, businesses, First Nations and local governments. It is the first in a series of open houses and public engagement opportunities designed to better understand community interests.

“We are committed to working closely with the community through every stage of the project,” said Tapics. “Our goal is to understand and address all community interests and considerations.”

The proposed Raven Underground Coal Project is a project of the Comox Joint Venture. The joint venture has been created to investigate the possibility of developing the Raven Underground Coal Project on Vancouver Island.
